- Circle of Friends provides opportunities for teens with special needs to develop social skills in a fun way.
- Teen volunteers and teens with special needs get together twice a month for activities that are both fun and rewarding.
- Activities are planned so that everyone can participate, no matter the disability.
- Activities are low cost or free.
- There is no charge for this service and you can join at any time.



## D.R.E.A.M Girls

DREAM Girls is an organization for girls ages 10-17 who are striving to become Determined, Responsible, Educated, Achieving and Motivated young women. "Living life by choice, not chance."

Junior DREAM Girls (grades 5-7) and Senior DREAM Girls (grades 8-12) are encouraged to:

- dream about their futures
- make good choices
- plan for their education and careers

Positive relationships with adult women in the community also help the girls overcome life challenges and increase their self-esteem. The girls have many more opportunities for activities, education and community action than they otherwise would experience.



## Youth Activity/Computer Center

The Stacy Youth Enrichment Center has six computer stations, a printer, a scanner, a digital camera, and a copier. Pre-teens and teens are welcome to work in an environmentally safe atmosphere and encouraged to do homework as well as refine their skills in other areas.



"Firewire," the Teen Technology Center and Student Lounge in Mora is open to students in grades nine through twelve.

Opportunities are available for students to explore the Internet in an environment that is filtered for safety. Students are also encouraged to do homework, experience artistic or musical interests and investigate future career paths.
